NIDA TEAP Applications, 1st Special Session, B.E. 2567 Academic Year (1/2567)

Sunday, 17 December B.E. 2566 at 17.00 – 19.00 (on-site and online)

The Center for Language and Communication Development Services, Graduate School of Language and Communication accepts NIDA TEAP applications for 1st special session for the B.E. 2567 Academic Year: on-site testing (at the National Institute of Development Administration, Bangkok) for students wishing to use results to apply for exemption from English language courses or admission to the Institute; and online testing for students wishing to use results for graduation. Details are as follows:

1. Application program

Announcing names of eligible test-takers	Wednesday, 13 December B.E. 2566. Names of eligible test-takers and the test locations are announced. - On-site test-takers are notified of test locations. - QR-Code is sent to online test-takers for admission to the test.
Test date	Sunday, 17 December B.E. 2566 at 17.00 - 19.00. Both on-site testing (test rooms at the Institute, Bangkok only, no off-campus testing) and online testing.
Announcing results	Friday, 22 December B.E. 2566 via the application system
Test rules	Test rules for both on-site and online testing are notified at the same that names are announced. All students must comply strictly with the test rules.
Note: This program is subject to change. Please refer to upcoming announcements of the Center. If you are unable to take the test, the Center <u>reserves the right to non-refundable payment and test deferment is not allowed</u> , saving for an error which the Center will decide on a case by case basis.	

2. Qualifications of applicants

2.1 Being a student of the Institute who has never used the result for an admission interview and is required to submit the result for graduation.

2.2 Being a student of the Institute who wishes to use the result to apply for exemption for English language courses (please refer to the announcement on criteria for exemption from English language courses).

2.3 An applicant wishing to use the result for an admission interview to study at the Institute as required by a School (has to contact staff of the School to receive a test ID for an exceptional case).

3. Test modes Applicants may choose one of the following test modes.

3.1 **On-site test:** to be taken in a test room at the National Institute of Development Administration. Results may be used for 3 cases : **being exemption from English language courses; application for admission to the Institute;** for graduation.

3.2 **Online test:** to be taken via an internet system developed by the Institute. Results may be used only for graduation. **Results cannot be used for exemption from English language courses or admission to the Institute.**

4. Application channel

4.1 Apply online via <http://lc2015.nida.ac.th/eng-exam/th>

4.2 Apply from 20 November to 5 December B.E. 2566 (late applications not accepted).

4.3 **Applicants must choose either on-site or online testing.**

5. **Test fee** 200 baht per person (two hundred baht) for both on-site and online testing (Non-refundable once applied).

6. Payment

6.1 Print the payslip and pay at any bank specified in the payslip; **or,**

6.2 Pay via any bank application specified in the payslip; **or,**


6.3 Pay at an ATM of any bank specified in the payslip.

6.4 Pay from 20 November to 5 December B.E. 2566 (late payment not accepted).

6.5 An applicant who fails to make payment via the specified channels or transfers the money to a wrong account, not the Center's account, the application shall be deemed incomplete. The applicant is responsible for retrieving the money. It is advised that a careful check be done prior to the money transfer.

The test rules that are announced should be studied and will be strictly complied with.
